Re: St. Anne's Indian Residential School


I write in reply to your letter of November 17, 2014 regarding the disclosure of documents in the Independent Assessment Process (IAP).

I regret that I have little to add to my letter of September 17, 2014. The issue of the St. Anne's IRS documents has been dealt with by the Ontario Superior Court of Justice. If further issues arise, it remains open to claimants' counsel to bring them to the Court's attention.

As it appears that fundamentally your concerns continue to relate to the conduct of Canada and its representatives, I ask that you direct your further communications in this regard to the Honourable Peter McKay, Minister of Justice and Attorney General for Canada and/or the Honourable Bernard Valcourt, Minister of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development.

As an officer of the court, it would not be appropriate for me to comment further in the political realm on matters that may be before the Courts in the future.
