The escalator (6% in 1995-96, 3% in 1996-97 and 2% in 1997-98) has been calculated on the \$3.4B global figure (established in 1994-95) and compounded annually. This annual increase is then adjusted to the department's base budget. The table below represents the annual escalator from 1995-96 to 2016-17.
